CUBE is a show that invites spectators to experience the rhythm and to take part in a unique event in which four performers and percussionists compose a show by adapting to the space that surrounds them and to the spectators who inhabit it, moving from a free and fragmented space to a constraining structure. This progressive compression of space will influence the performers' gestural vocabulary as much as the emotional charge conveyed. Power and resilience are at the heart of this powerful work that celebrates the human capacity to adapt in the face of adversity.
